Doug Cunningham is a native of Atlanta. He joined the U.S. Navy after graduation from high school where he tracked Soviet submarines across the North Atlantic and Mediterranean for six years on P3 aircraft.

He earned a Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting from The University of Georgia and was recruited by the FBI. He graduated from the FBI academy in Quantico, Virginia, and became a special agent specializing in forensic accounting. Most of his service with the FBI was focused on drug introduction investigations involving Columbian and Mexican cartels importing large quantities of cocaine and heroin into the United States. The most public case he was involved in was John DeLorean, where DeLorean was running a criminal enterprise in an effort to generate enough money to keep his car company alive.

Throughout his career he identified and seized, under the RICO statute, over US\$20 million in cash; 15 properties; numerous cars, airplanes, and boats/yachts; and hundreds of kilos of drugs.

Following his time with the FBI he entered the world of software sales, where he held various roles from account executive to vice president of sales. In 2015 he decided to retire from software sales and entered the ministry of bio-forensic restoration. In 2016 he purchased 50% interest in Georgia Clean and Associates LLC, a bio-forensic remediation company in the South East.
